## We wish to report:

1. Consider **Resolution No. 21- 21** A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING MONIES FOR CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

Section 1. There is hereby an appropriation of the unappropriated balance of the 100 General Fund, in the amount of \$32,850.00(Licking County's half of Rain One bill for sprinkler system at the courthouse)

**Director David Rhodes** – The City of Newark in partnership with the Licking County Commissioners replaced the sprinkler system on courthouse grounds. The total cost was a little bit over \$64,000, the bill is due and we are going to move forward and pay the county's half, we sent them a bill and they are going to send us a check back. Since the contract is with the city, we pay the bill in full and then they pay us back.

Mr. Harris – I've noticed a few trees being removed around the square, are they going to replace any trees?

Director Rhodes – We're still talking about that and that's the next item I'm going to talk about.

Mr. Bubb – I thinks this is long overdue and hopefully this system won't run when it rains like the old one did.

Director Rhodes – These are dollars we are requesting to fund the new position in cemetery/parks. If you notice in section 3, it's the same request. This position is being funded 3 different ways. Through the general fund, then I will get approximately half of what we fund from the general fund back through the SID and then the water department is funding approximately 1/3 also. We will move the money, I'll request from the SID and I will then put it back in.

Mr. Roger Loomis – Just to clarify that is money from Storm Water not the Water Department.

Mr. Marmie – I see that, it's from the 669 account.

**Mr. Blake** – Since the SID is going to be paying a portion of this, how much of this employees time is going to be dedicated to the downtown area?

**Director Rhodes** – In the summertime they will spend more time in the downtown area, really this is a position for the entire City. They'll also work with special events with the parks. If you can remember at one point we had a special events coordinator and it was all on the General Fund. The City has limited the number of events that we personally put on and have moved more to a collaboration on special events with other entities. So, in the summertime more time in the downtown area, but it's a year round position.

**Mr. Marmie** – So, Mr. Rhodes, just to clarify, one third is coming from the SID, one theird form General Fund and one third from Storm Water, correct?

**Director Rhodes – Correct.**
