Director Mauter- I sent out an email about this for some history because I know some of you may not be familiar with this, Carol I know you are very familiar with this it was in your back yard for many years. It was what we called the pink house that was part of the HoDAG. The main thing is there are several projects with these grant funds that originated back in 88 and 89 were put towards and the mortgage payments that have come in over the last 10 years or so has generated the \$307,550.00 that you are seeing here on the appropriation. There has been some discussion with several developers who might have some potential projects that we can put this to some good use for.

3. LATE ITEM- Resolution No. 17-73 appropriating monies for the current expenses of the municipal corporation. Expedite.

Mrs. Floyd- this is a late item that can't be voted on tonight but it can go to Council under Rule 11 next Monday night.

Director Rhodes- this is additional dollars for salt. When you wind up going down a curvy road occasionally you have some things that sneak up on you and this is one of those. There is some additional salt out there that Newark has committed to buy from last year's salt budget and we are going to honor that commitment. This is out of the unappropriated funds of the Street/Traffic Department. To appropriate that money now and to buy the salt now or do you pay an \$11,000.00 storage fee on the salt and pay for it out of next year's budget which would be the same money. We decided to not pay the storage fee and take the salt in. That is why we are appropriating this money out of the Street/Traffic account hence we will have enough salt to do the whole year this year and the contract that we sign next year the amount of tons we enter into will be lower and our budget will reflect a lower amount in the salt budget for 2018 as well as saving \$11,000.00 in storage fees.

Mr. Fraizer- how time sensitive is this? **Director Rhodes**- please expedite this.
