We wish to report:

- 1. **Resolution 14-63** appropriating and disappropriating monies for the municipal corporation was considered.
  - a) A request for an appropriation of the unappropriated balance of the 100, General Fund, in the amount of \$700.00 (Donation for Courthouse fountain)

**Director Rhodes**- we got a 3 year commitment from the Downtown Newark Association for the courthouse fountain and last year we took a little money out of building maintenance and ground to make up their 2 year commitment that was coming to finish that project. We received their 2<sup>nd</sup> year commitment of \$700.00 and would just like to have that re-appropriated to the building ground and maintenance fund where it originally came from.

  - a) City Auditor, Steve Johnson- the County Budget Commission sets our tax rates, this is something that Council does every year. The Clerk of Council must file this with the Budget Commission by October 1. By addressing this tonight the Clerk will have plenty of time to do that.
