We wish to report:

 Resolution No. 18-97 a resolution of intent to appropriate the real estate known as parcel #054-191250-00.00, Newark, Licking County, for maintaining and improving Arlington Avenue within the city of Newark, Ohio; authorizing the Mayor to give notice to the owner of such lands as required by law; and declaring an emergency was considered.

Brian Morehead- both of these pieces of legislation are similar they are for two separate properties on Arlington Ave and it is for Safe Routes to School project that we received some funding for. We are replacing the sidewalk along Arlington Ave and installing sidewalk where there isn't one now. We have tried to negotiate with both property owners but we have not been able to make contact with either one of them so we need to move forward with the appropriation. The first one is for \$300.00; it is for a temporary easement. Basically it is an easement after we install the sidewalk to be able to grade back up into the yard which is a temporary easement.

Mr. Rath- why are they different in price?

Brian Morehead -it is the valuation based on the appraisals.

Mr. **Rath**- we didn't have any objections from the property owners just no response correct?

Brian Morehead- correct, no response. On the first piece of legislation the owner has recently deceased.
