We wish to report:

 Ordinance No. 16-26 changing the zoning classification of certain real property, generally described as 965 Mt. Vernon Road, City of Newark, Licking County, Ohio, from that of RM – Single Family Residence Medium Density Zoning District, to GB – General Business Zoning District was considered.

Director Rhodes- this property here is adjacent to Pizza Cottage. This is the beginning of a process and we ask that the committee pass it so that it can go to Council for the first reading then go to the Planning Commission and then we will give you an opinion on it and come back to Council with that.

Motion by Mrs. Floyd to send to full Council, second by Mr. Bubb Motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

2. **Resolution No. 16-55** authorizing and directing the Director of Public Service to participate in the ODOT winter contract (018-17) for road salt and declaring an emergency was considered.

Director Rhodes- this contract period would run about October through next winter. Currently we have about 2 thousand tons of salt on hand. We are comfortable taking in another 17 hundred tons. This is the lowest price available.

Mr. Rath- you said that we have 2 thousand tons on hand right now what do we usually have on hand in July?

Director Rhodes- it is a full salt barn currently. Normally about a thousand but the reason we had additional was because it was a mild winter.

Motion by Mr. Bubb to send to full Council, second by Mrs. Floyd Mr. Fraizer- is this going into the barn? **Director Rhodes**- no we will enter into contract to buy it and then we have it reserved per contract so as we use what is in the barn we can refill and we can do that anytime through the winter. It is basically a commitment that we are going to buy x amount of salt. If it is March and we haven't taken it all in we are still obligated to take it in and put it in the barn.
