- 1. Roger Loomis, Utilities Superintendent, discussed Resolution No. 11-108 authorizing and directing the service director to apply for, accept and enter into a water pollution control loan fund agreement on behalf of the city for planning, design and/or construction of wastewater facilities (Raccoon Creek Interceptor) and designating a dedicated repayment source for the loan.
- 2. Rhonda Loomis asked for an update on the Chuck Jackson agreement to wit: a five year lease beginning April 1, 2011 and being in effect for five years. Mr. Jackson has use of the land (one acre), house and is required to perform forty hours of labor per month at T. J. Evans Park. The house is near the park on State Route 13. The city pays water, sewer, gas and electric bills; this raises Mr. Jackson's salary by \$9,600 annually.
