We Wish to Report:

1. **Ordinance No. 16-11** vacating a portion of a 16.5 foot wide alley running north from West Main Street, between properties at 108 and 112 West Main Street was considered.

Brian Morehead- both of these items were before you as resolutions that passed as an intent to vacate both of these. Last fall they slipped between the cracks and we never finished them off with an ordinance to vacate. Basically that is what we are doing here. On this alley there was no opposition from any of the safety forces or anyone else for that matter so we ask for your consideration to send to full Council for a vote.

Motion by Mr. Rath to send to full Council, second by Mr. Johnson

Mr. Rath- was there a public hearing on this?

Brian Morehead- you had a committee meeting previously then you voted on the resolutions at a Council meeting last fall but you will also have a public hearing before you vote on this at the next Council meeting.

Motion passed by a vote of 7-0.

2. **Ordinance No. 16-12** vacating a portion of a 12 foot wide alley as shown on the plat of the John McCune's addition, as recorded in plat book 2, page 246 of the Licking County plat records, located between properties at 301 and 303 Clinton Street was considered.

Brian Morehead- this is the same situation your resolution of intent passed last fall. In both of these cases I should have stated on the last one the property owners that adjoin the alley have signed a petition so there is no notice necessary to be published so there are not publishing fees will be due from the property owners. On the Clinton Street one the same owner actually owns both sides of the street now.

Motion by Mr. Rath to send to full Council, second by Mr. Bubb
