The Finance Committee met in Council Chambers August 5, 2024 with these members in attendance:

## We wish to report:

**Mr. Marmie** - The unappropriated balance of the General Fund is \$627,730.00 and the balance of the Budget Stabilization Fund is \$757,681.00.

1. **Resolution No. 24-67 Exp** A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING MONIES FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

Section 1. There is hereby an appropriation of the unappropriated balance of the 220 Fund, in the amount of \$220,999.00 (Ohio Ambulance Transportation Impacted Industry Program Grant)

**Barbara Gilkes** – This appropriation pertains to the Ohio Ambulance Transportation Impacted Industry Program Grant. This is a grant that the Division of Fire was eligible and was awarded this amount of money. It will be equally divided amongst the firefighters who were onboard on the date of application, which was May 20<sup>th</sup>, and are still here.

2. **Resolution No.24-68** A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEWARK TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT LEAD HAZARD CONTROL AND HEALTHY HOMES FOR A LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**Ms. Gilkes** – This grant is due on August 19<sup>th</sup>. The local match is 10%, and as the title implies, it's to remove lead hazards in housing. It can be both owner occupied and rental.

Mr. Marmie – Right, but we won't have a meeting to vote on it until the night of the 19<sup>th</sup>. Is that ok?

Ms. Gilkes – That's ok.

Mr. Marmie - Ok. Just checking.
