1. Consider **Resolution No. 24-15 CI** A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING MONIES FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE MUNICPAL CORPORATION

David Rhodes, Service Director - The first item, the \$43,000, we are going to replace the roof at the Hollander Fire Station. It might raise a few questions, why would you replace a roof when you are going to build a new station, our plan is to keep that building in tact, we might use it for storage, or we've had some private sector people contact us that might have a use for it, we're probably a couple of years away from a new Fire Station so, we thought it was the right thing to do to put a roof on it. That building is built I a flood district so it would be very hard to build another building if we tore it down.

Director Rhodes - In the Traffic Department for the City we have a sign machine, we make signs. We don't make all of the signs within the City, but we do make a lot of signs and the machine is on it's last leg, so we've negotiated to get a new sign machine. One thing I like about this is the film on the new machine is a graffiti film, so if they come in and spray it, we can wipe it clean.

Mr. Rath - Unrelated topic. I'm assuming ODOT takes care of the signs on 16 and 79, not us, is that correct?

Director Rhodes - ODOT does take care of some signs, not all of the signs, yes.

Mr. Rath - When I'm coming west on 16 into downtown at night, they are nearly impossible to read, even with knowing where the roads are I still have a hard time seeing and figuring out what exit.

Mr. Chute - Just for clarification, both of these expenditures, \$43,000 in Building Improvement and \$48,000 in machinery and equipment are both under Resolution 24-15, so I'm not going to take another vote on that, so we'll send that on to full Council.
