WHEREAS, the City of Newark owns approximately 47 acres of marked trees of material located off of E. Main Street and Ecology Row; and

WHEREAS, the City of Newark entered into an agreement with Agent Wit Brothers Forestry, LLC to be the Forest Manager for this project; and

WHEREAS, the harvesting of said timber is an economically beneficial opportunity for the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, an emergency is declared to exist to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Newark.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: It is in the best interest of the City of Newark and its residents that the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate and enter into a contract for the harvesting of timber located off of E. Main Street and Ecology Row in a portion of Q3, Lots 3 and 4 owned by the City of Newark in Madison Township, Licking County, Ohio.

SECTION 2: An emergency is declared to exist to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the City of Newark inhabitants. Therefore, this Resolution shall be immediately effective as provided in City of Newark Charter, Article 4.07.
