

Request for Legislation

Project Title: Water Distribution/Sewer Maintenance Utility Vehicle

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT, SUBJECT TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NEW SERVICE TRUCK AND UTILITY BED FOR THE WATER DISTRIBUTION/SEWER MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT.

Background/Purpose:

The City has approximately 182 miles of sanitary sewers, 244 miles of water lines and almost 20,000 customers throughout the City that require routine and emergency maintenance by Water Distribution and Sewer Maintenance staff. The City currently has a Utility vehicle with 93,000 miles on it and needs replacement. Additionally, the new Utility truck will have a service crane added to it to allow staff to more efficiently and safely work on fire hydrants and other heavy assets in the field.

Scope of Work:

The Division of Water and Wastewater, through the Director of Public Service, is requesting authorization to purchase a new 2-wheel drive cab and chassis and Utility bed. This current legislation authorizes that process to start.

Justification/Urgency:

City vehicles are routinely replaced to ensure safe and functional vehicles are available for staff to use daily on routine and emergency maintenace.

Anticipated Costs and funding source:

The Water/Sewer Division has funding to purchase the truck and utility bed. The truck is \$63,155 and the utility bed is \$53,700, putting the combined total for the truck/bed over the \$75,000 threshold. The truck is State pricing and the utility bed is the cheapest out of three estimates.

Schedule:

The truck and utility bed will be purchased for the City pending passage of the legislation.

Community Impact:

This project will benefit the City by ensuring a reliable truck is available for staff as well as adding added efficiency and safety through the addition of the crane while replacing an aging asset.
