

INSPECTION NOTICE: Contact the City of Newark Engineer's Office at 740-670-7727 at least 24 hours in advance to schedule the inspection of forms prior to placing concrete.

The following items shall be considered as a condition of this permit and failure to comply will be reason for revocation and/or other penalties as determined by City Ordinances:

- 1. Traffic control shall be per the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, latest edition, and other applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code and Codified Ordinances of the City of Newark, Ohio. The contractor shall provide, erect and remove all signs, barricades and other necessary traffic control devices to warn and/or detour traffic around construction work. All traffic control shall be in place prior to any work activities.
- 2. All work shall conform to the standards and specifications of the City current on the date of approval of this permit. The City Engineer shall determine the thickness and composition of the pavement.
- 3. The applicant shall notify all utilities and the Ohio Utilities Protection Service (1-800-362-2764) no less than 48 hours prior to any excavation activities. (ORC 153.64)
- 4. The applicant shall restore all areas disturbed by his/her operations to their original, or better condition, insofar as practical.
- 5. A copy of this permit must be placed on site during the hours of activity that was stated on the permit application.
